C. EXCHANGE SERVICE AREA - Which is that area described as follows:

Commencing at the west 1/4 post, Section 20, T6S, R6E, Dundee Township, Monroe County; thence east to the center of Section 22; thence south to Cake Road; thence east to Davis Road; thence south to the north line, Section 35; thence east to the northeast corner Section 36; thence south to the northwest corner Section 6, T7S, R6E; thence east to the point 1/4 mile west of Haines Road; thence south to a point 1/10 mile south of the north line Section 8; thence west to the north-south quarter line, Section 7; thence south to the south line of Section 18; thence west along Ida Center Road to the northeast corner of Section 23, T7S, R6E; thence south to the southeast corner of Section 26; thence west to the northeast corner Section 34; thence south to the southeast corner; thence west to the southwest corner of Section 32; thence north to the point of beginning.
